PROGRAM CONTENT

Unlike last year's two day seminar which had as its unifying theme the evidence based evaluation of currently held concepts, this year we have chosen to focus on three very exciting areas of contemporary clinical practice.

On Wednesday, Dr. Gianelly will discuss in depth the "Bidimensional Technique" which is a multibracketed edgewise technique utilizing advanced biomechanical principles and metallurgical technology. He will explore appliance design and rationale as they apply both to nonextraction and extraction treatment, with case study documentation. He will also discuss the concept of maxillary lip position as a diagnostic factor in profile analysis.

Dr. Tuncay's subject on Thursday will be "The Practical Efficiency of Removable Thermo-vacuum Formed Appliances." From their inception as a significant tool in clinical practice, he has been intimately involved in their development and utilization. He brings to us a wealth of experience with these clear appliances. He will emphasize patient selection, appliance management and modification, motivation, finishing and retention.

For Friday's presentation, Dr. Baccetti's topic will be "Dentofacial Orthopedics in Four Dimensions." An experienced researcher in this field, he will dwell upon TIME and TIMING as the fourth dimension in dealing effectively with the problems we encounter in the three planes of space. He will address the subjects of case selection, treatment timing, appliance design and placement, appliance management and retention. Like the other speakers, Dr. Baccetti will document his presentation with selected case studies.

It is our hope that we will be able to take home and utilize in our practices the concepts and clinical methodologies presented by these respected educators and clinicians. At the end of each session, adequate time will be made available for questions and for dialogue among our speakers, as well as between the audience and our speakers.

We are most fortunate to have these three speakers whose lofty thoughts do not prevent them from having their feet on the ground. It is this combination which will enable us to produce solid results for our patients.
